

Erasmus+ scholarship for the SoMu semester in Stockholm or Tartu

General information

- Travel expenses to/from Stockholm and Tartu will not be covered.
- You do *not* receive the money on a monthly basis. Instead, you receive two payments: the second one only after your mobility semester (after the official confirmation of departure).
- Can be combined with “AuslandsBAföG”, cannot be combined with any other DAAD scholarships.

Application requirements

- You are enrolled at JGU (home institution).
- You have completed at least 2 semesters of your studies by the time your Erasmus+ semester starts.
- You have sufficient English skills (language of instruction) and basic skills of the local language.

Application documents (checklist)

- ☐ **CV**
- ☐ **Transcript of Records** or **Academic Certificate** that lists your completed courses and grades. Vytautas Magnus University issues this document upon your request. If you cannot obtain the Academic Certificate before the deadline, please contact Aurelija Tamošiūnaitė at atamosiu@uni-mainz.de
- ☐ **Letter of motivation** that covers your qualifications and motivation, academic and personal reasons for your choice, describes your study aims at the host institution, etc. Please make sure you indicate your contact information (first and last name, e-mail) in the letter.
- ☐ (Optionally) (Language-) diplomas (if you have some)

- Language competence
- Motivation
- Social aspects

After successful application
